Some members, led by Glen, have also spent much time and effort assisting with the installation of shelving and racks in the newly constructed shed at the rear of the Wirraminna Op Shop.

The Men's Shed is a concept which is growing in popularity and increasing in number in Australia and around the globe. It provides an outlet for men, much in the same way that the backyard shed has in Australian culture over many years. The Southern Barossa Mens Shed (SBMS) welcomes men from all walks of life to attend our Shed, you can participate in a range of activities in the workshop if that is your desire or you can simply turn up for 'a cuppa' and socialise with others in a non pressured setting. The Men's Shed does not follow a strict format but it does encourage fellowship. Projects are also undertaken which benefit the community.

#### **Lyndoch Reflection Sofa**

The Reflection Sofas are a focus and a prompt to continue conversations about suicide prevention. It is hoped that they will assist in the reduction of stigma associated with suicide. In addition, they will enable people to reach out for help and assist people to reach in to help when someone is struggling. A QR code installed on the front arm rest is a link to supportive services and information.

From a volunteers perspective, we set up our Lyndoch design workshop in April this year where a group of interested locals learned about Seeds of Hope, the structural process and we had the opportunity to input ideas on particular 'Lyndoch' features that we would like to incorporate into our sofa.

Have a look at the Banjo Frogs on the lower front panel, there is a good chance you'll be able to hear the frogs distinctive call from the creek. The featured wattle leaves and flowers are from a local sample and of course the New Holland Honeyeaters are prolific in our region.

A huge thank you to St Johns Lutheran Church for generously allowing us to set up a workshop in their Hall for several months. It was here that the mosaic panels were put together on netting for transferral to the sofa. Many of us (including me) were totally new to the world of mosaic, thankfully the project was led by the talented and highly skilled Mosaic Artist, Kristen Wohler who, along with some other experienced artists guided and mentored us, making sure we didn't stuff it up!

Its been a privilege to be part of this collaborative project, to meet some wonderful people. The artwork that you will see today has been a true community effort and we hope that people will use the sofa as intended. Thank you also to the Lyndoch Community Committee for supporting and hosting the opening event.




#### LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY
