





LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The Barossa Council has recently been hosting a delegation from the Sister City of Grapevine, Texas who was in the area during the Vintage Festival.

Thirty-seven years ago, as part of the State's Jubilee 150 in 1986 the District Council of Barossa decided to twin Lyndoch with Georgetown, Texas and in February American visitors were welcomed to Lyndoch. During the year residents from Lyndoch made return visits to Georgetown. An album of information was exchanged, and a welcome was held at the District Council Memorial Building.

As part of cultural celebrations on 31st October Lyndoch followed the American tradition of Hallowe'en "Trick or Treat" night. 100 children dressed as ghosts, witches, skeletons, cats, and Dracula caused a lot of excitement. A special feature was Roy Malone's "haunted" house on Jollytown Road with music and lights that gave it an authentic appearance.

On 18th December the official naming and dedication of "Georgetown Reserve", Lyndoch was held to commemorate the twinning of Lyndoch and Georgetown, Texas, during the Jubilee 150 celebrations.

The community can have their say on a proposal by NRMA to install an **electric**

vehicle (EV) charging facility at the Nuriootpa Soldiers Memorial Hall. NRMA approached The Barossa Council earlier this year to explore potential Council sites in the vicinity of Nuriootpa, after establishing its first site at the Barossa Visitor Centre in Tanunda in 2020.

The site is the NRMA's preferred location because of its proximity to the highway and local amenities, including public toilets and shops.

The community is invited to comment on the proposal between 23 August and 13 September 2023, with information available at barossa.sa.gov.au.

If no objections are received during community consultation, Council will go ahead with the necessary licensing arrangements.





1837 BAROSSÁ



Our winery 1837 Barossa commemorates the date on which Colonel William Light, founder of Adelaide and first Surveyor-General of South Australia named the Barossa in December 1837.

The Barossa Colonel Light Monument, a life-size bronze statue of Colonel Light on horseback honours the birthplace of the Barossa on the estate. Our label is symbolizing Colonel Light pointing towards the Barossa Range when naming them in 1837.
