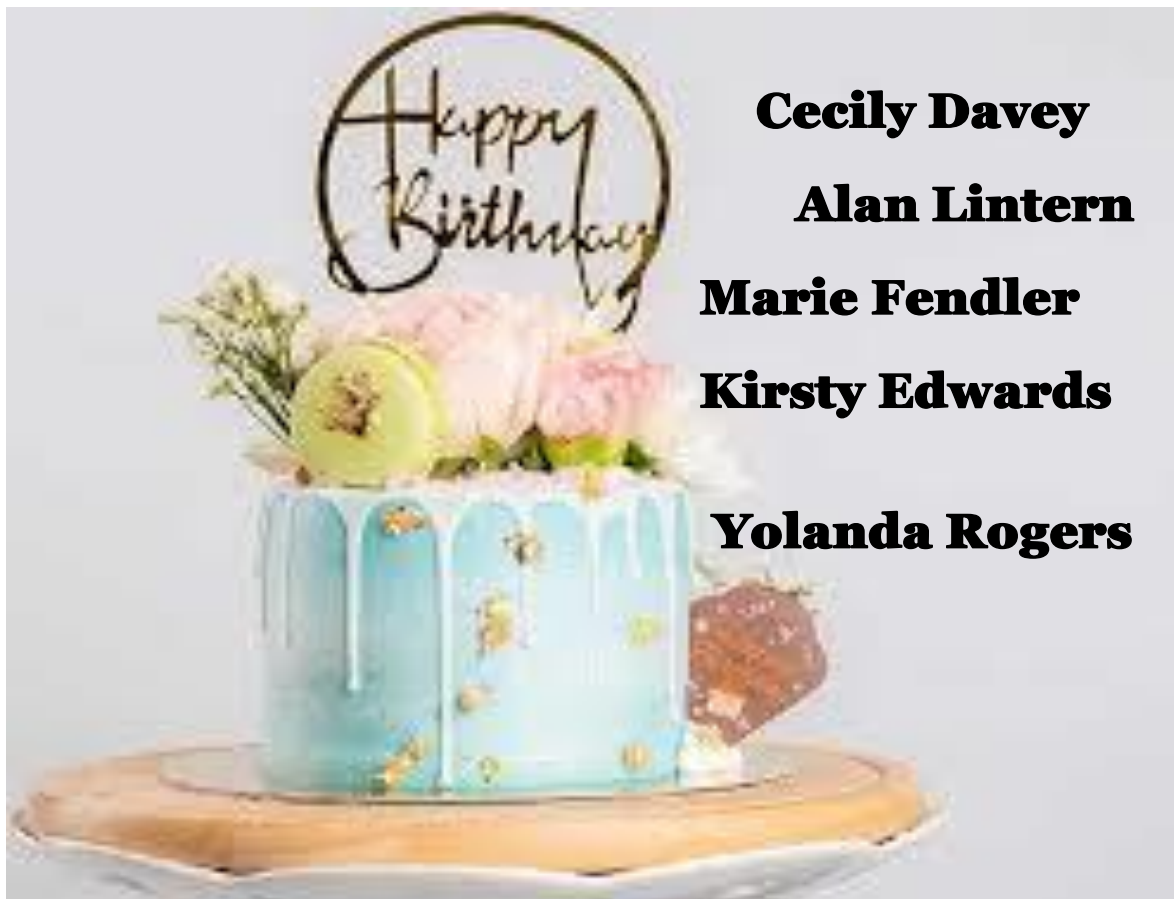

April	8 & 9 April
July	15 & 16 July
October 2023	30 September & 1 October

What will be accepted: clean residential green waste, including:

- Grass clippings
- Prunings
- Leaves
- Small branches, up 100mm in diameter

What will not be accepted:

- Commercial loads of materials
- Waste or hard rubbish
- Soil
- Proclaimed weeds, these include: rose, poplar, blackberry, gorse, olive, bridal creeper, kikuyu, couch and bamboo

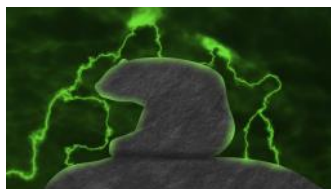

The benefit of using Native fire-retardant Plants

A fire shelter belt is a barrier of trees, shrubs and ground cover plants located strategically to reduce heat and the chance of ember attack on a house.

Please note no plant is fire proof – some plants are either fire retardant in that they don't tend to burn, depriving an active fire of fuel and reducing the area of opportunity to ignite.

Please note, nearly all plants that are classified as a fire-retardant plant require maintenance to reduce the risk of fires taking hold this include removal of low branches – dead branches – dry litter on ground and bark on the tree trunk to expose fire risk.

Native fire-retardant plants act as radiant heat screens and absorbs most of the heat of an approaching fire that should help reduce an area without severely burning an area. They trap sparks and embers carried by wind, and can reduce and slows the travel time of a fire through debris and litter on the ground.

Please note that these plants can slow a fire down, most likely not stop a fire in its tracks, but may burn once dried.
