



- Commercial loads of materials
- Waste or hard rubbish
- Soi
- Proclaimed weeds, these include:rose, poplar, blackberry, gorse, olive, bridal creeper, kikuyu, couch and bamboo


The petition will be available to sign at the Hall when you pick up your mail. Please help us to ensure that it is maintained once again.
